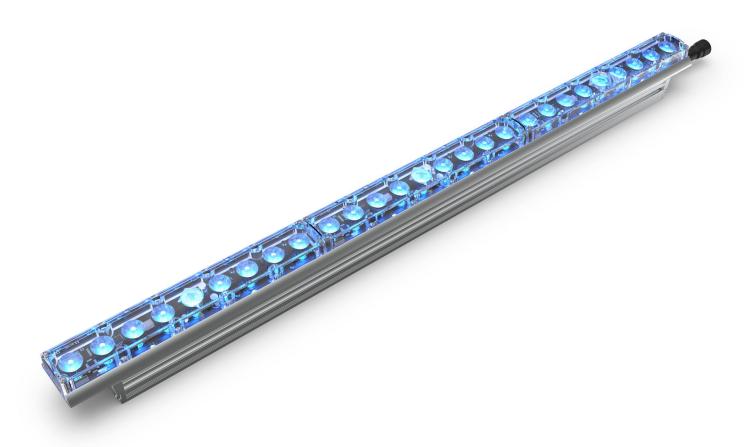

#### Personal Safety

- Avoid direct eye exposure to the light source while the product is on.
- Always disconnect the product from the power source before cleaning.
- Always connect the product to a grounded circuit to avoid the risk of electrocution.
- Do not touch the product's housing when operating because it may be very hot.

#### Mounting and Rigging

- The luminaire is intended for professional use only.
- The product should be positioned so that prolonged staring into it at a distance closer than 3.3 ft (1 m) is not expected.
- Do not submerge this product (IP66). Temporary outdoor operation is fine.
- When using this product in an outdoor environment, use IP65 (or higher) rated power and data cables. Secure unused power and data ports with attached IP65 covers.
- CAUTION: When transferring product from extreme temperature environments, (e.g., cold truck to warm, humid ballroom) condensation may form on the internal electronics of the product. To avoid causing a failure, allow product to fully acclimate to the surrounding environment before connecting it to power.
- Not for permanent outdoor installation in locations with extreme environmental conditions. This includes, but is not limited to:
  - Exposure to a marine/saline environment (within 3 miles of a saltwater body of water).
  - Locations where the normal high or low temperatures exceed the temperature ranges in this manual.
  - Locations that are prone to flooding or being buried in snow.
  - Areas where the product will be subjected to extreme radiation or caustic substances.
- Mount this product in a location with adequate ventilation, at least 20 in (50 cm) from adjacent surfaces.
- Make sure there are no flammable materials close to the product when operating.
- When hanging this product, always secure to a fastening device using a safety cable.

#### Power and Wiring

- Make sure the power cord is not crimped or damaged.

- If the external flexible cable or cord of this product is damaged, it shall be replaced with a special cable or cord exclusively available from the manufacturer or its service agent.
- The light source contained in this luminaire shall only be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or a similarly qualified person.

#### Operation

- Do not operate this product if there is damage on the housing, lenses, or cables. Have the damaged parts replaced by an authorized technician at once.
- Do not cover the ventilation slots when operating to avoid internal overheating.
- The startup temperature range is -4 °F to 113 °F (-20 °C to 45 °C). The operating temperature range is -40 °F to 113 °F (-40 °C to 45 °C).
- The storage temperature range is -40 °F to 167 °F (-40 °C to 75 °C).
- Do not start, operate, or store the product outside of the above temperature ranges.
- In the event of a serious operation problem, stop using this product immediately!

# **Expected LED Lifespan**

Over time, use and heat will gradually reduce LED brightness. Clustered LEDs produce more heat than single LEDs, contributing to shorter lifespans if always used at full intensity. The average LED lifespan is 40,000 to 50,000 hours. To extend LED lifespan, maintain proper ventilation around the product, and limit the overall intensity.

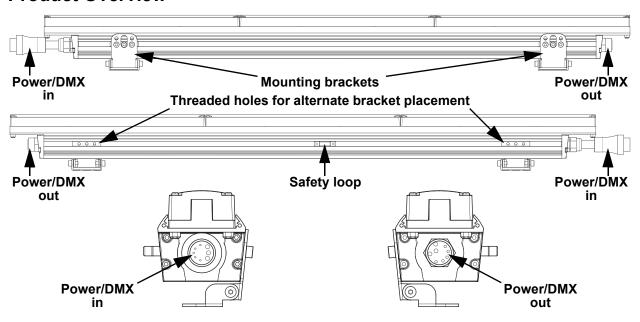

## **Description**

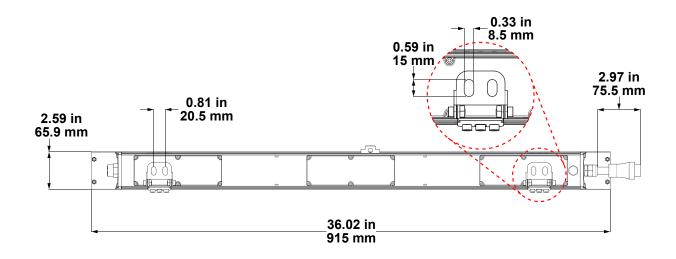
The Ilumiline ML is an outdoor-rated linear batten with a sleek, low profile and RGBL color mixing. It features plug-and-play installation with an optical system that delivers stunning, fully-mixed colors. The three-foot version is perfect for fitting into available space, while interchangeable, easy-to-install beam spread filters to help the fixture adapt to various applications and throw distances. Additionally, the lime emitter allows the Ilumiline ML to create not only brilliant, saturated colors, but crisp and clear whites to beautify any building, for any weather conditions.

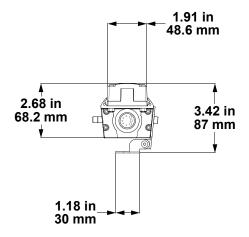

# 3. Setup

#### **AC Power**

The Ilumiline ML has an auto-ranging power supply and it can work with an input voltage range of 100 to 277 VAC, 50/60 Hz.

To determine the product's power requirements (circuit breaker, power outlet, and wiring), use the current value listed on the label affixed to the product's back panel, or refer to the product's specifications chart. The listed current rating indicates the product's average current draw under normal conditions.

Always connect the product to a protected circuit (a circuit breaker or fuse). Make sure
the product has an appropriate electrical ground to avoid the risk of electrocution or fire.



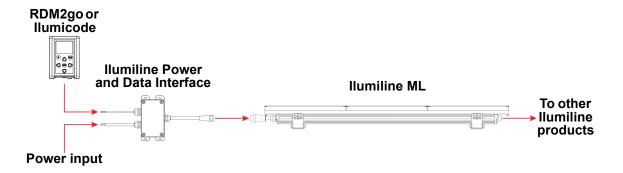
- To eliminate unnecessary wear and improve its lifespan, during periods of non-use completely disconnect the product from power via breaker or by unplugging it.
- Use only proprietary IP66 waterproof cables and secure unused ports with attached IP66 covers.



Never connect the product to a rheostat (variable resistor) or dimmer circuit, even if the rheostat or dimmer channel serves only as a 0 to 100% switch.

#### **Ilumiline Power and Data Interface**

The Ilumiline Power and Data Interface (sold separately) combines power and data into 1 cable. Download the QRG for the Ilumiline Power and Data Interface from <a href="www.iluminarc.com">www.iluminarc.com</a> for more details.



## **AC Plug**

The Ilumiline Power and Data Interface (sold separately) comes with a bare-ended power input cord. Use the table below to wire a plug.

## **Power Linking**

The product supports power linking. You can power link up to 15 products at 100 V, up to 18 products at 120 V, up to 27 products at 208 V, up to 30 products at 230 V, up to 31 products at 240 V, or up to 32 products at 277 V.

Proprietary 2-in-1 power and data linking cables are available from Iluminarc for purchase.

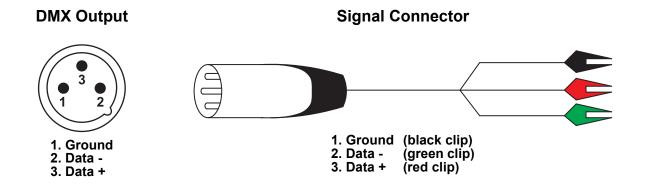

#### **DMX Linking**

The Ilumiline ML will work with a DMX controller using a standard DMX serial connection. A DMX Primer is available from <a href="https://www.iluminarc.com">www.iluminarc.com</a>.

#### **DMX Connection**

The Ilumiline Power and Data Interface (sold separately) provides a DMX-512 connection using bare-ended IP66-rated signal cable. This cable comes connected to the product.

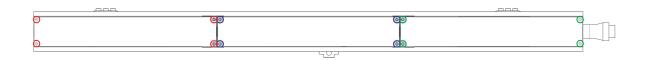


# Remote Device Management (RDM)

Remote Device Management, or RDM, is a standard for allowing DMX-enabled devices to communicate bi-directionally along existing DMX cabling. Check the DMX controller's User Manual or with the manufacturer as not all DMX controllers have this capability. The Ilumiline ML supports RDM protocol that allows feedback to make changes to menu map options.

# **Beam Shaping Filters**

The Ilumiline ML can be used with the 20°, 40°, 55°, or 60°x10° beam-shaping filters (sold separately). To change a filter, remove the 4 screws indicated below for the desired filter.

## Mounting

Before mounting the product, read and follow the safety recommendations indicated in the Safety Notes.

#### Orientation

Always mount this product in a safe position, making sure there is adequate room for ventilation, configuration, and maintenance.

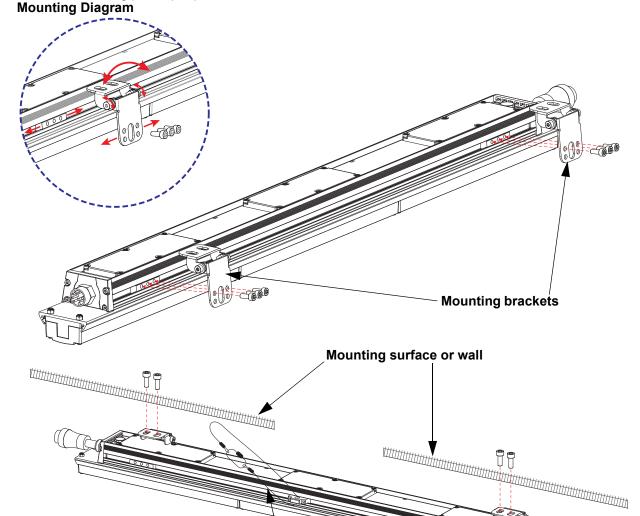
#### Rigging

Chauvet recommends using the following general guidelines when mounting this product.

- Before deciding on a location for the product, make sure there is easy access to the product for maintenance and programming purposes.
- Make sure that the structure onto which you are mounting the product can support the product's weight. See the <u>Technical Specifications</u> for weight information.
- When mounting the product overhead, always use a safety cable. Mount the product securely to a rigging point, whether an elevated platform or a truss.
- When rigging the product onto a truss, use hardware of appropriate weight capacity.

#### **Procedure**

The Ilumiline ML comes with two adjustable brackets which can be secured directly to a mounting surface. Make sure the mounting surface and hardware are capable of supporting the weight of this product. Use at least two mounting points per product.

# **Configuration (DMX)**

Use control configurations to operate the product with a DMX controller.

#### **Control Personalities**

To set the control personality:

- 1. Go to the **PERSON** main level.
- Select the desired personality, from ARC1, ARC1+D, ARC2, ARC2+D, ARC FULL, SOLID, SPECIAL1, or SPECIAL2.



- See the <u>Starting Address</u> section for the highest starting address you can select for each personality.
- Make sure that the starting addresses on the various products do not overlap due to the new personality setting.

#### **Starting Address**

Each product will respond to a unique starting address from the controller. All products with the same starting address will respond in unison. To set the starting address:

- 1. Go to the **DMX** main level.
- 2. Select the starting address (001-512).

# **Configuration (Static Mode)**

To set the Ilumiline ML to operate in a static or strobing color without DMX:

- 1. Go to the **STATIC** main level.
- 2. Select the parameter to configure, from
  - RED
  - GREEN,
  - BLUE,
  - COOL (lime),
  - SOLID (no function), or
  - STROBE
- 3. Set the selected parameter to the desired level, from 000-255.
- 4. Repeat until the static mode is set as desired.

# **Configuration (Settings)**

#### **Dimmer Speed**

To set the dimmer speed:

- 1. Go to the **DIMMER** main level.
- Select the dimmer speed from OFF (linear dimmer), DIM1 (fastest), DIM2, DIM3, or DIM4 (slowest).

#### Color Calibration

There are 4 color calibration options for the Ilumiline ML: **OFF** (maximum output/unbalanced white), **RGBTOW** (quad-color calibration), **UC** ("universal", tri-color calibration to match legacy products), and the color macro **WHITE 1–11** settings.

To select the color calibration mode:

- 1. Go to the **SETTINGS** main level.
- 2. Select the COLOR option.
- 3. Select the calibration mode, from OFF, RGBTOW, or UC.

#### **Color Macro White Balance**

To adjust the color macro white balances:

- 1. Go to the **CALIB** main level.
- 2. Select the macro to adjust, from WHITE 1-11.
- 3. Select the color level to adjust, from RED, GREEN, BLUE, or COOL (lime).
- 4. Set the level of the selected color, from 000-255.
- 5. Repeat until the white balances are set as desired.

#### **RGBTOW Mode**

To adjust the color calibration in **RGBTOW** mode:

- 1. Go to the **CALIB** main level.
- 2. Select the RGBTOW option.
- 3. Select the color level to adjust, from RED, GREEN, BLUE, or COOL (lime).
- 4. Set the level of the selected color, from 000-255.
- 5. Repeat until the calibration is set as desired.

#### **Universal Calibration**

To adjust the color calibration in **UC** mode:

- 1. Go to the **UC-CALIB** main level.
- 2. Select the color level to adjust, from RED, GREEN, or BLUE.
- 3. Set the level of the selected color, from 000-255.
- 4. Repeat until the calibration is set as desired.

#### **Factory Reset**

To reset the product to factory default settings:

- 1. Go to the **SETTINGS** main level.
- 2. Select the **RESET** option.

# 5. Maintenance

#### **Product Maintenance**

Dust build-up reduces light output performance and can cause overheating. This can lead to reduction of the light source's life and/or mechanical wear. To maintain optimum performance and minimize wear, clean your lighting products at least twice a month. However, be aware that usage and environmental conditions could be contributing factors to increase the cleaning frequency.

To clean the product, follow the instructions below:

- 1. Unplug the product from power.
- 2. Wait until the product is at room temperature.
- 3. Use a vacuum (or dry compressed air) and a soft brush to remove dust collected on the external surface/vents.
- 4. Clean all transparent surfaces with a mild soap solution, ammonia-free glass cleaner, or isopropyl alcohol.
- 5. Apply the solution directly to a soft, lint free cotton cloth or a lens cleaning tissue.
- 6. Softly drag any dirt or grime to the outside of the transparent surface.
- 7. Gently polish the transparent surfaces until they are free of haze and lint.



Always dry the transparent surfaces carefully after cleaning them.
